– Project Superintendent –



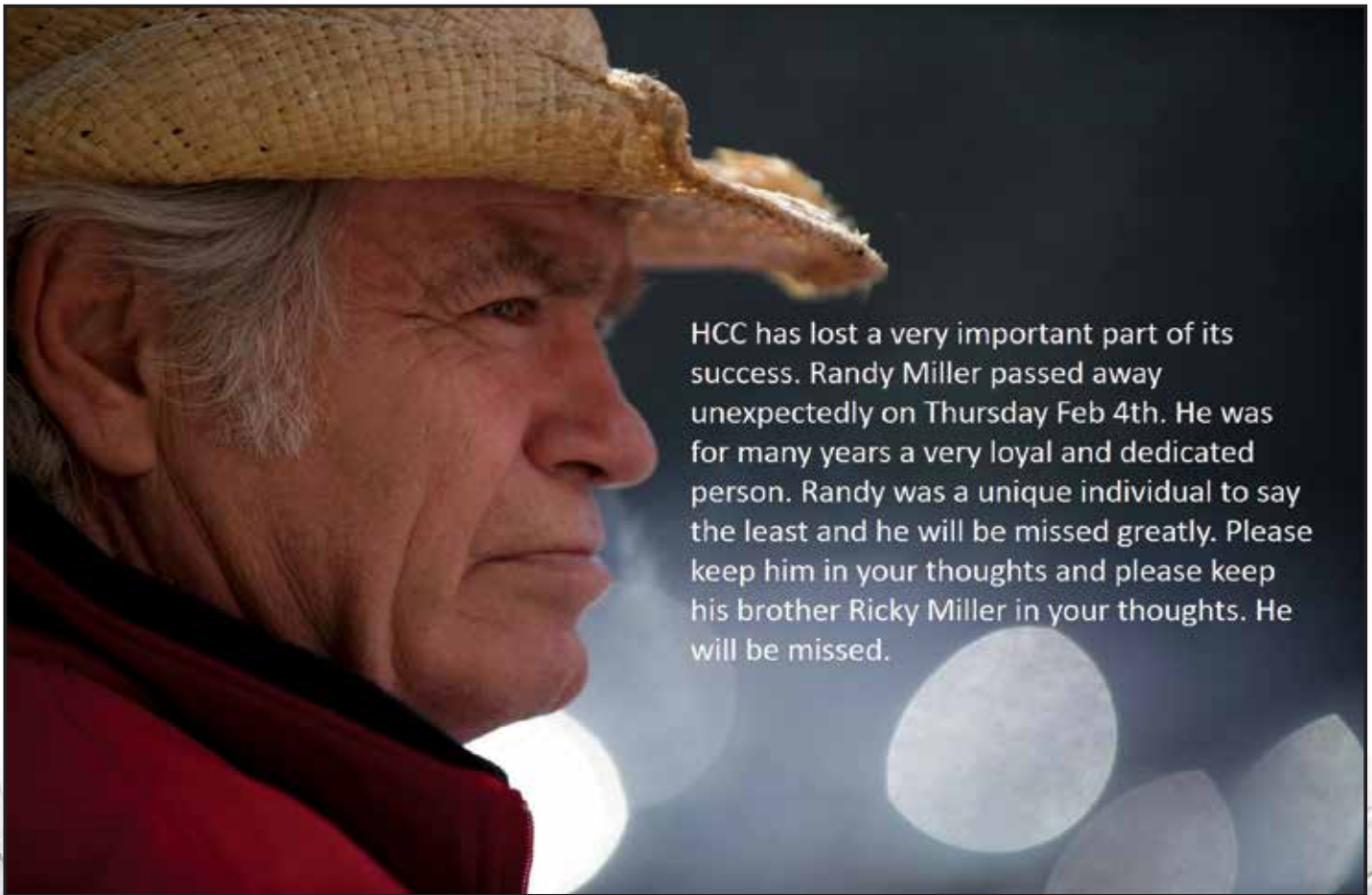

## Safety First



## LIFT WELL LIVE WELL

Improper lifting is a major cause of back related injuries on the job. Below are some tips for heavy lifting that are sure to minimize the risks.

- 1) **Always use both hands** when lifting a heavy or cumbersome object.
- 2) **Adopt a proper stance** for lifting: put the strain on your legs, not your back (crouch at your feet, keep your back straight, and don't bend at the waist). Lift slowly and smoothly.
- 3) **Test the weight** before you lift something. It might be too late if you realize a few seconds later that it's too heavy or cumbersome for you. Get help if you need it.
- 4) **Consider a back brace** if the work is heavy or you have a sensitive back.
- 5) **Move your feet, not your back**, when you want to travel or turn while carrying a heavy load.
- 6) **Keep your burden close** to your body; this means less strain on you.
