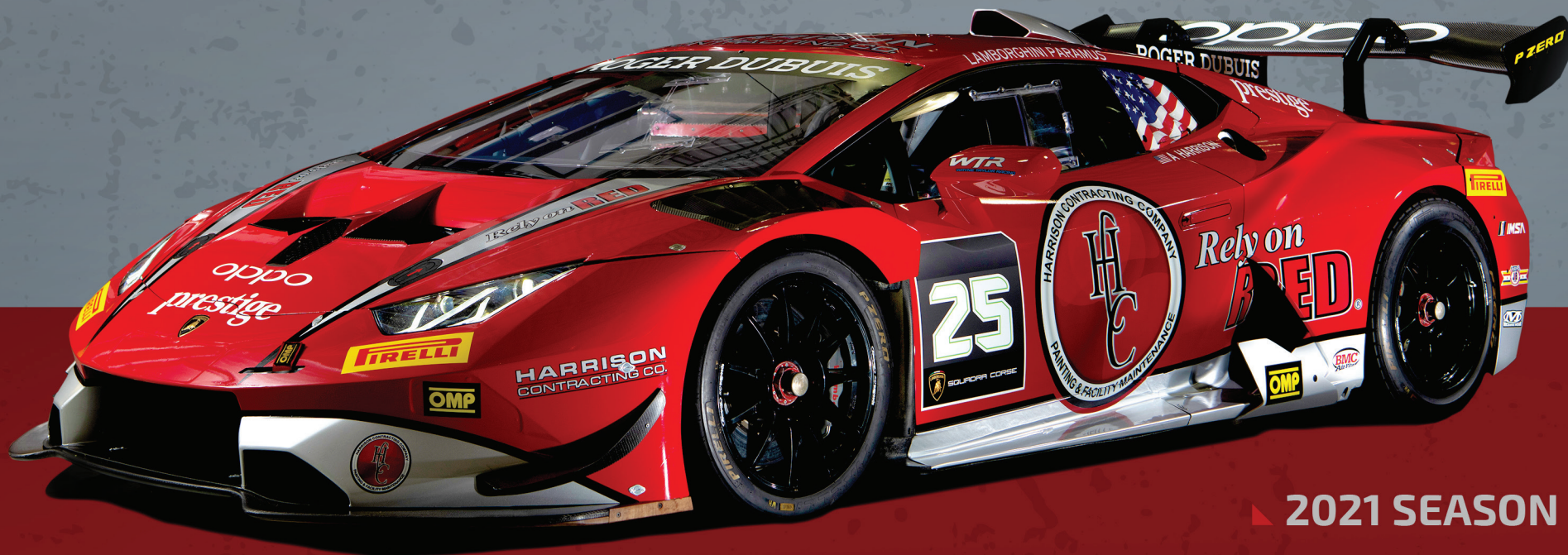

Harrison Contracting Lamborghini Huracán Super Trofeo

- Finished 2020 season with one win, seven podiums and three pole starting positions.
- First female to win a Lamborghini World Finals race.
- Fastest laps in the LB Cup class at Barber Motorsports Park (Round 1 & 2), Watkins Glen International (Round 3 & 4), Road America (Round 5 & 6) and WeatherTech Raceway Laguna Seca (Round 9 & 10).
- Secured class pole positions in Barber Motorsports Park (Round 1), Watkins Glen International (Round 3), Road America (Round 5) and WeatherTech Raceway Laguna Seca (Round 10), Jerez, Spain (Round 11) and the Lamborghini World Finals (Race 2).
- Mazda MX-5 Cup Series with GB Racing supported by Racing Analytics. Worked closely with Mazda factory driver, Tom Long.
- Her desire to pursue racing was sparked even more when her father initially took her to the Bondurant School of High Performance Driving in 2010 in order to remove points off her Georgia license (or the state said she would lose her license).
