



WHAT IS BLOCK FILLER, AND HOW TO APPLY IT PROPERLY

Block filler is a primer or sealant that's used to fill porous masonry surfaces like concrete block and cinder block. This is applied before a finish coat of paint to ensure the surface has a more smooth profile.

When applying block filler, it's best to use an airless sprayer with a 535 spray tip and a 1 - 1 1/4" nap roller cover.

Starting at the top of the wall, spray a large amount of the block filler on the surface, almost to the point that it is running down the wall. Then, using your roller, back roll the block filler across the wall. This pushes the product into all the small holes, voids, pores and crevices in the surface.
